Defending MA Thesis through an article submitted to an academic journal

- Students are allowed to defend their MA thesis as an article accepted by the supervisor and submitted to a peer-reviewed academic journal. In such a case, an email confirmation of submission from the journal is required.
- 2. When defending their MA thesis as an article submitted to a peer-reviewed academic journal, students are required to provide a supplement. The supplement should include the following:
 - a. **Extended Literature Review**. The review should include a minimum of 5 pages, approximately 2500 words, excluding bibliography. An additional Reference list with work quoted in the Literature Review should be provided.
 - b. **Extended Methodology**. The examples of the content to be included in the Methodology are:
 - i. For works using primary qualitative data:
 - 1. Interview scripts
 - Coding tree/Coding scheme
 - ii. For works using primary quantitative data
 - 1. Questionnaire for data collection
 - 2. Quantitative analysis plan
 - 3. Sampling frames
 - 4. Output from program analyzing data, e.g., with descriptive statistics statistics
 - iii. For works using secondary data:
 - 1. Data selection criteria
 - 2. Output from program analyzing data, e.g., with coded excerpts
